Given the extent of the work and the uncertainty of the world, the original 18 month timeline seemed impossible, yet here we are poised to move the collections and staff back into our beloved Roy O. West Library on schedule.


The move in process will start with the books which have been in storage locally since June of 2021. Starting November 1, our book mover will assemble shelving on the third and second floors and then begin putting the collections in place from the top of the building down to the lower level where Archives and Special Collections will be the last to move into their space. Roy staff will move into offices after January 2 and the building will open for spring semester on January 30.

Locations & Services at Roy

The Roy O. West renovation is an adapted re-use of over 70,000 square feet, including a three-story addition. Throughout the four floors of the library, there are numerous individual and collaborative study spaces, restrooms and water fountains/bottle filling stations, as well as a return of the beloved treehouses!

Lower Level:

- Brand new entrance on Indiana Street
- Archives and Special Collections reading room (collection materials can begin to be requested after Spring Break 2023)
- Café Roy coffee shop with generous seating
- General Collection books A-G (in new compact shelving)
- Film viewing room
- Lactation room

First Floor:

- The Desk check out and return books; pick up ILL requests; work with Peer Research Consultants
- Academic Resource Center
- Reading Room with double sided fireplace
- Non-gendered restrooms
- Tenzer Touch Screen Visualization Wall

Second Floor:

- Tenzer Maker Lab, Tech Lab, and **Active Learning Classrooms**
- General Collection Books H-K
- Reading Room Overlook

Third Floor:

- General collection books I-7
- Meditation Room
