The Dean's Preface


A note from Dean of the Libraries, Brooke Cox

Since opening January 30, through to March 1, we've recorded 2,042 study room checkouts in our library management system!

Have you visited our new Compact Shelving yet? Located on the Lower Level of Roy O. West Library, these shelves sit on tracks that allow the shelves to move using a manual crank. This allows us to store a large amount of books in a smaller space, while not having to limit our collection.
