Roy O. West Library is once again bustling with traffic and it's so much more than studying. There are students 3D printing in the Maker Lab, peer tutors offering one-on-one consulting about writing assignments, faculty engaged in conversations about classroom technology, and so much more. It seems like a good time to reintroduce the other folks in the building and invite you to visit.

The **Tenzer Technology Center** is a high-tech collaborative space where students from all disciplines enhance their technology literacy to support their personal and career aspirations and prepare to work and live in a diverse and global world. Their spaces, programs, and services are available to the entire DePauw community. During the 2023-2024 academic year, Tenzer powered classrooms hosted 30 different courses. Tenzer directly supported 25 courses impacting 500 students and hosted or co-sponsored 30 events with more than 1200 participants.

Faculty Instructional Technology Support (FITS) assists faculty members in enhancing their teaching and their students' learning through the latest tools with an emphasis on the pedagogical applications of technology rather than with explicit technical training. They provide consultations to help leverage these technologies to design effective assignments, class projects, and assessments for courses.

The Learning Commons includes the W, Q, and S Centers. Students can schedule appointments with tutors who are ready to provide practical suggestions, encouragement, and advice about all sorts of classwork: essays, problem sets, oral presentations, research projects, homework. The Learning Commons had 1365 scheduled appointments for 23-24.

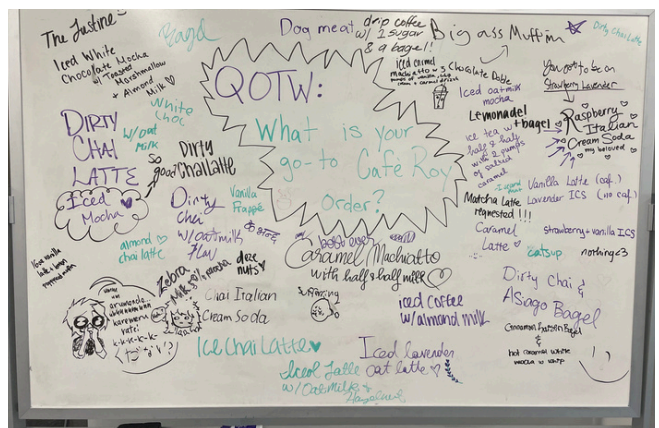
